### COMMUNITY SOFTBALL CLINICS

- This clinic is designed for those individuals who coach community club ball at the B or C level (U10 through to U18).
- For those B and C teams who are attending provincials it is a requirement that there be 1 coach on the roster who has completed the Community Softball Clinic (or old Level 1) course and the making ethical decisions module and on-line exam.
- Clinic contains the following components: Theory, Technical, Practical and Making Ethical Decisions.
- Duration of clinic – approximately 14 hours

### COMPETITION INTRODUCTION CLINICS

- **Mandatory for 2014** – All “A” teams attending Provincial Championships are required to have 1 coach on the roster who has completed the Competition Introduction (or old Level 2) course and the making ethical decisions module and on-line exam.
- This clinic is designed for those individuals who coach at the A level (U14 A through to Senior A).
- Competition Introduction includes the following components: Theory, Technical, Making Ethical Decisions and a Practical Evaluation.
- The Competition Introduction Clinic takes place over two weekends. Following the clinic there is a 1 ½ hour evaluation component. Information on the evaluation component will be given at the clinic. The evaluation component is required for Competition Introduction Certification.
